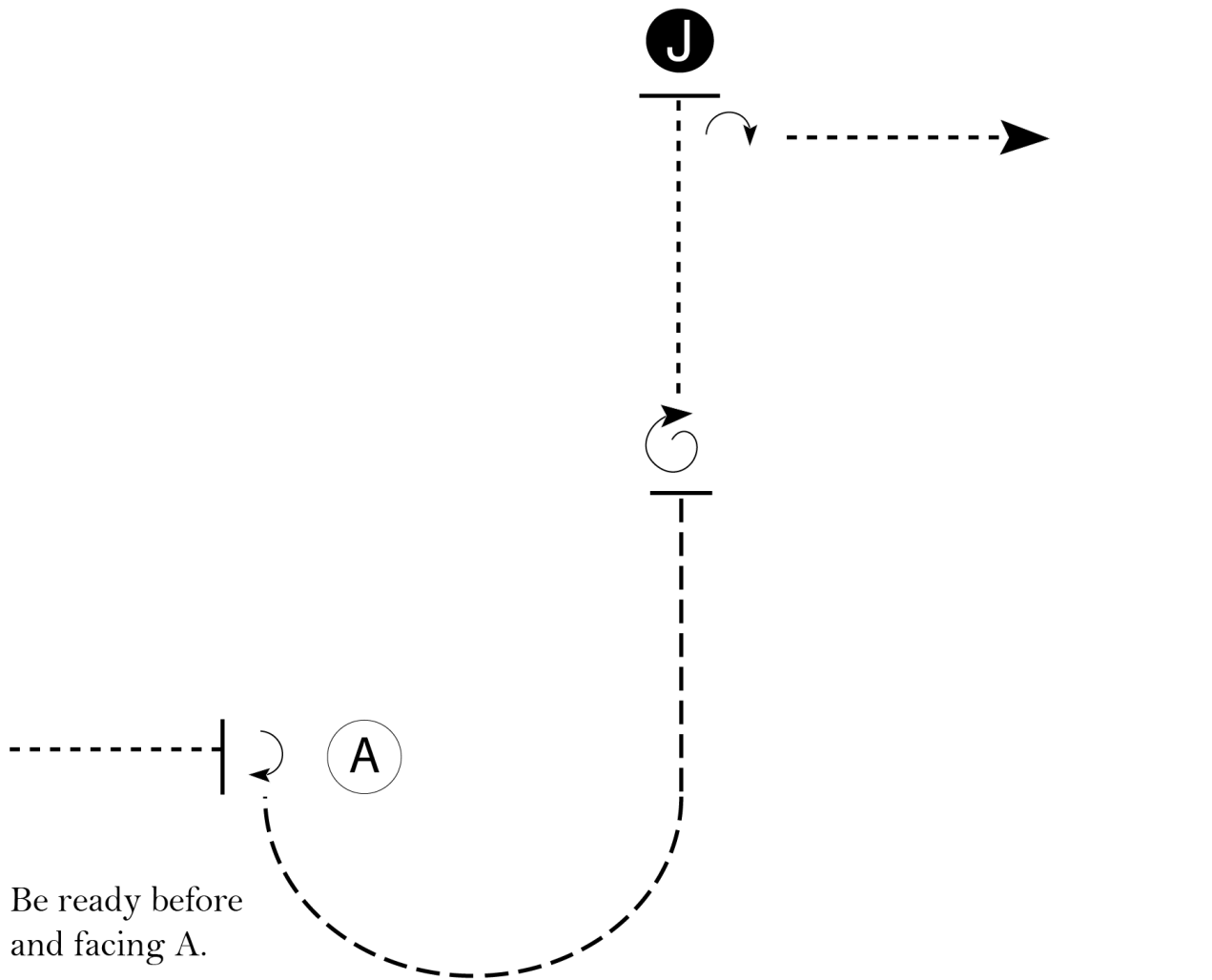

4. Stop and perform a full (360 degree) turn.
5. Walk to judge and set up for inspection.
6. When dismissed, perform a 1/4 turn and walk straight away from Judge.

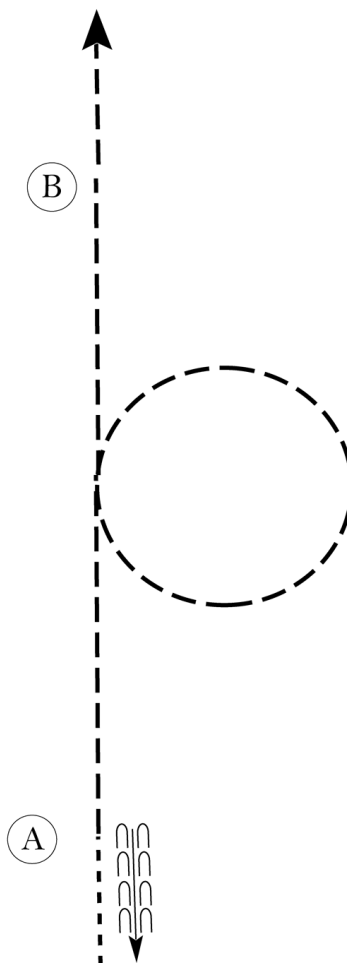

2. Walk to A.
3. Sitting trot to center of pattern.
4. Posting trot a circle to the right.
5. Posting trot on the right diagonal straight away from B.

Pattern is over once you have trotted past B more than 2 horse lengths.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

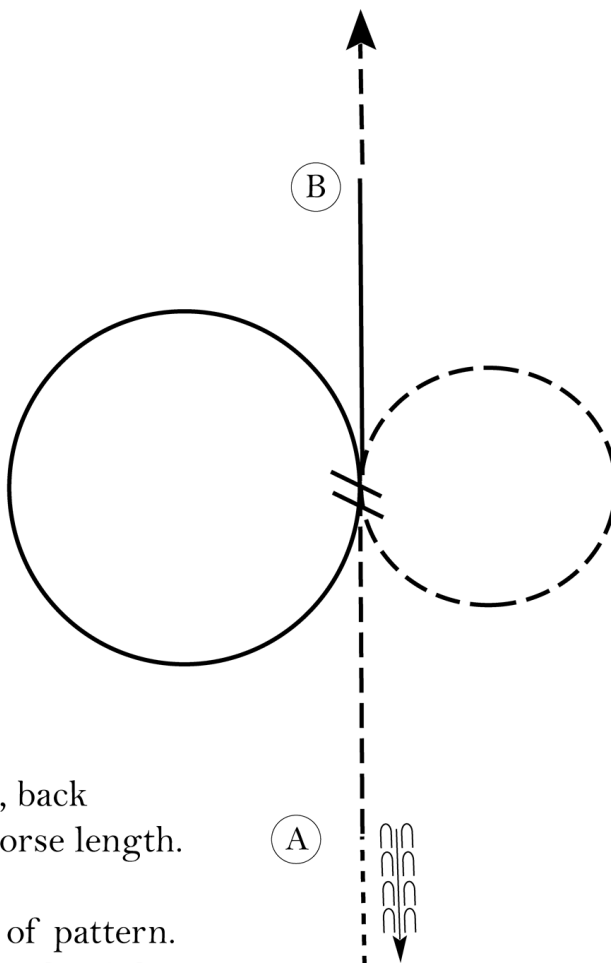

7. Canter to B.
8. Posting trot on the right diagonal straight away from B.

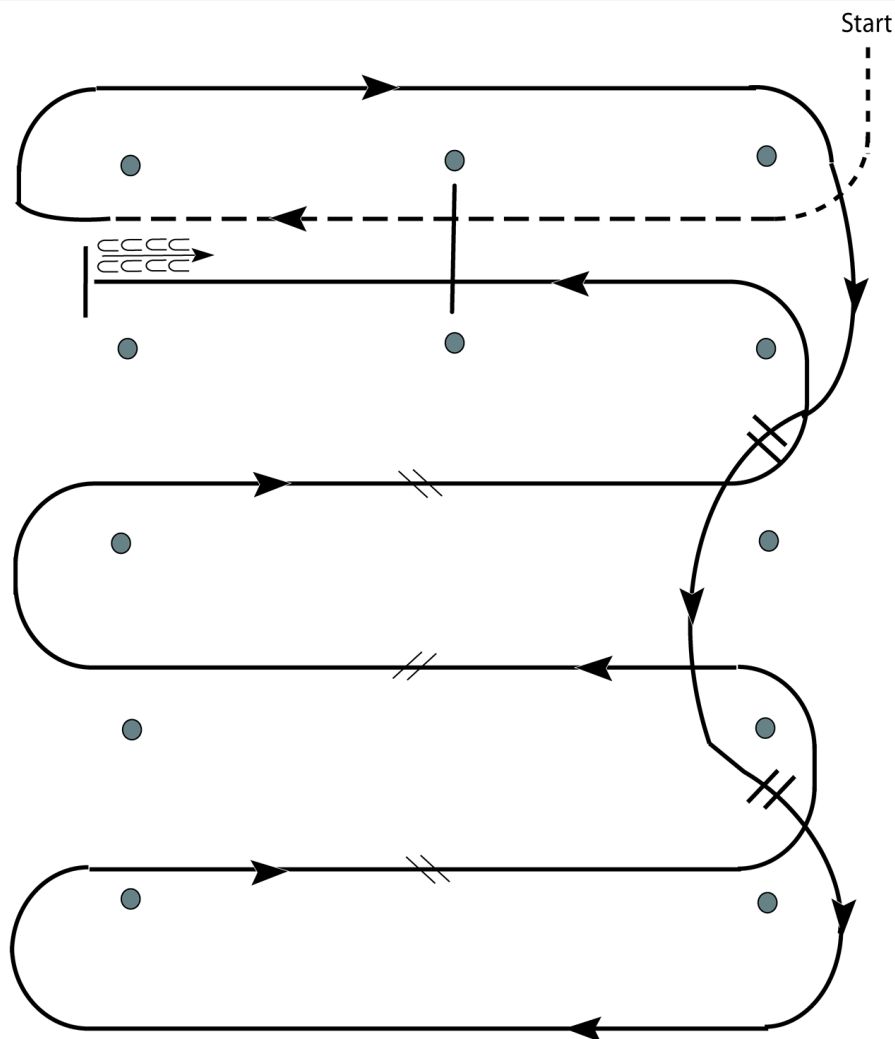

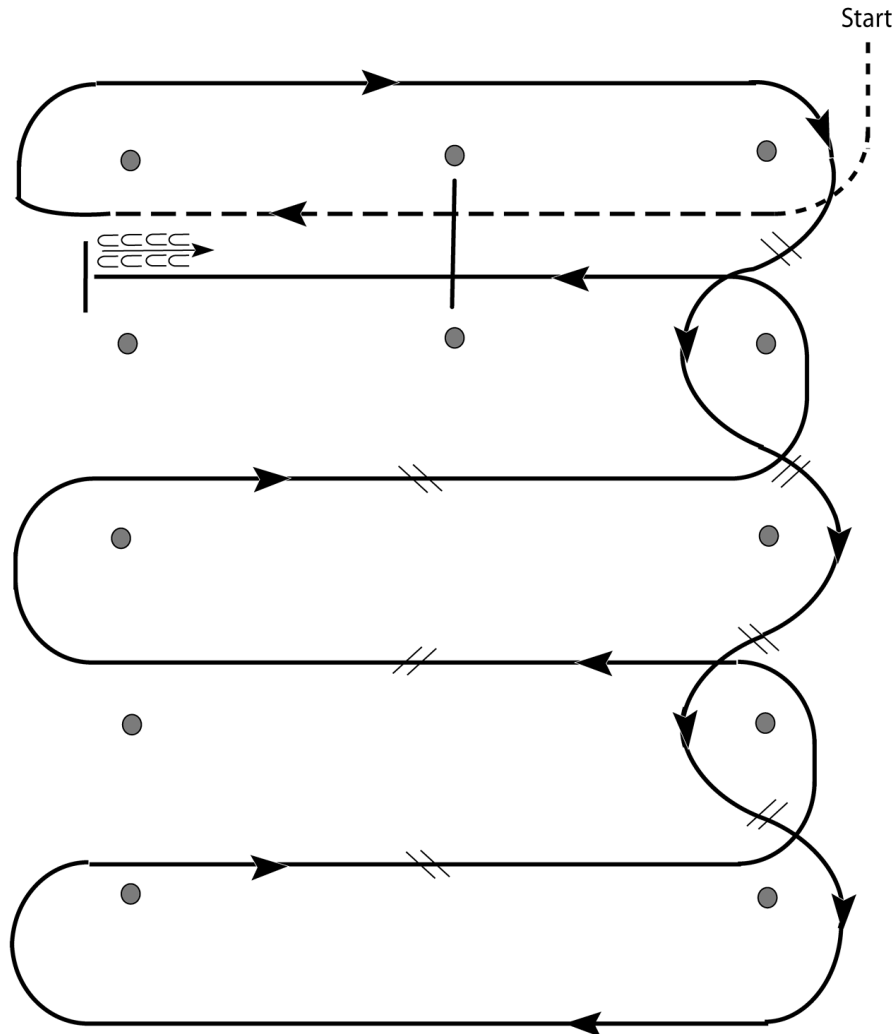

12. Extended trot
13. Trot
14. Stop and back

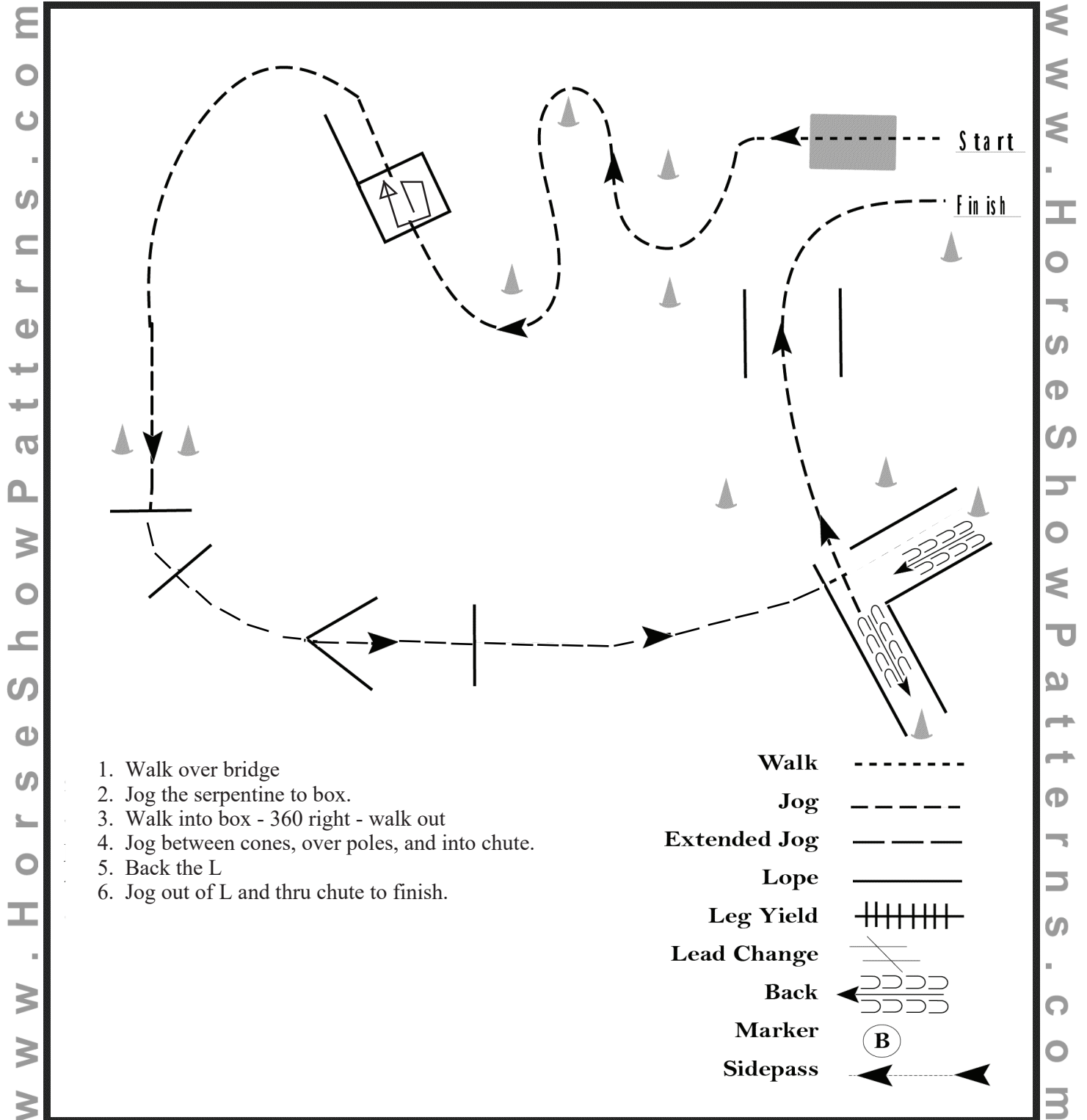
